



CARRIAGE OF DRY ICE

General

This course is aimed at candidates who are involved with the consignment of non-dangerous goods freight, for example, food or samples packed in Dry Ice by airfreight. Candidates will gain an understanding of the strict IATA regulatory requirements surrounding the safe transport of this material. The course learning outcomes will be assessed at the end of the course with validation for two years.

- Packaging Instruction for Dry Ice consignments
- Markings
- Labels
- Document Completion
