



DRIVER CPC DEFENSIVE DRIVING FOR BUS AND COACH DRIVERS

General

"Defensive Driving for Bus and Coach Drivers" was one of the first courses approved for Driver CPC training. The course is a classroom based, seminar style programme designed for drivers of all passenger carrying vehicles. It is highly interactive and will raise awareness of defensive driving issues with even the most experienced of drivers. The course uses presentations, workbook exercises, interactive Highway Code and hazard perception sessions in order to encourage discussion and development of safe driving issues on the public road.

Certification

All trainees will be certificated and their attendance on the course will be notified to the Joint Approvals Unit for Periodic Training (JAUPT).

Course Content

The course covers:

- Defining and explaining the benefits of Defensive Driving
- The Challenges of the Driving Environment
- Driving skills and knowledge
- Attitudes and behaviour
- The differences in PCV driving
- The additional responsibilities of the PCV driver

Course Duration

The course is one training day (7 hours) long.

Max trainee / instructor ratio is 20:1.
