



DRIVER CPC DRIVER'S FIRST AID AT WORK

General

The "Driver's First Aid at Work" course is the first day of the HSE three day First Aid at Work (FAW) course. The seven hours training on the first day is approved by the Joint Approvals Unit for Periodic Training (JAUPT) for Driver CPC. The course is classroom based with a number of practical elements. It is designed for drivers with little or no first aid knowledge who wish to raise their first aid knowledge to the FAW level. The course uses presentations, Resusi-Anne dolls, First Aid handbooks and training dressings.

Course Content

The course covers:

- The Principles of First Aid
- Action to be taken in an emergency
- Priorities of treatment
- Unconsciousness & Recovery Position
- Asphyxia
- Chest injuries
- CPR
- Wounds and Bleeding
- Dressings
- Scenario Exercises

Course Duration

The course is one training day (7 hours) long. The remainder of the three day course continues but is not Driver CPC approved.

Course Loading

Max trainee / instructor ratio is 12:1

Course Location

Public courses are held regularly at Specialist's training centre at Altham, Lancashire or at customer premises or suitable nearby locations nationwide.

Certification

All trainees will be certificated and their attendance on the course will be notified to the Joint Approvals Unit for Periodic Training (JAUPT). To receive certification for the First Aid at Work course, trainees have to complete the remaining two days, and successfully pass the assessments.
