Examinations

The open book examinations are organised by the Scottish Qualifications Authority (SQA) 4 times a year, March, June, September and December at central locations nationwide. To gain a DGSA qualification you need to have a pass result in three examination papers, Core, Mode and Classes. The examinations need to be booked 4 weeks in advance of the exam date.
